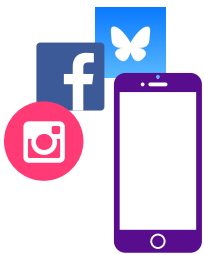


Key messages:

- West of Scotland Sexual Assault Service is a (SARC). It is a specialist service to support anyone who has been sexually assaulted or raped within the last 7 days. Archway Glasgow is the main contact hub.
- If your assault happened more than 7 days ago, we can still help.
- We support people of all ages, although we may need to do extra checks if you are under 18. We have special guidance for those under 18: archwayglasgow.scot/young-people-under-18
- Our service is appointment-only but we are open 24 hours a day, 7 days a week and you can call us anytime.
- You can come to us through the police by calling 101, or you can self-refer by visiting [NHS inform](http://NHS.inform) or calling us directly on 0141 211 8175.

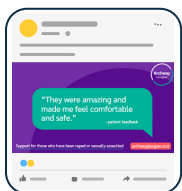

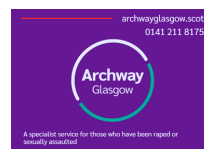
